The Government of Uttarakhand has received financing from the World Bank towards the cost of the Uttarakhand Rural Water Supply & Sanitation (URWSS) Project-Additional Financing for Disaster Mitigation, and intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services.

(i) Age of the firm; (ii) Number of Post Graduate Social Sciences, Graduate Civil Engineering, M.Com as an associates or employee with the firm; (iii) Completed similar assignment since last three financial year (i.e from 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2011); (iv) Experience of working in similar geographical areas (i.e Himalayan belt of India) and (v) Average annual turnover in last three financial year.

The attention of interested Consultants is drawn to paragraph 1.9 of the World Bank's Guidelines: Selection and Employment of Consultants [under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants] by World Bank Borrowers, dated January, 2011 ("Consultant Guidelines"), setting forth the World Bank's policy on conflict of interest.

Consultants may associate with other firms in the form of a joint venture or a sub-consultancy to enhance their qualifications.

A Consultant will be selected in accordance with the Qualification & Cost based Selection-Lump-sum method set out in the Consultant Guidelines.
