The Government of Uttarakhand has received financing from the World Bank towards the cost of the Uttarakhand Rural Water Supply & Sanitation (URWSS) Project-Additional Financing for Disaster Mitigation, and intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services.

The consulting services “Impact Analysis of Uttarakhand Rural Water Supply & Sanitation Project” include to analyze the URWSSP implementation experience of the project in improving the effectiveness of rural water supply and sanitation (RWSS) services through decentralization and increased role of the Panchayati Raj Institutions and the involvement of local communities in the state of Uttarakhand .

The State Water & Sanitation Mission, Uttarakhand now invites consultancy firms to indicate their interest in providing the services. Interested firms must provide information indicating that they are qualified to perform the services (brochures, description of similar assignments, experience in similar conditions, availability of appropriate skills among staff, etc) Consultants (firms) may associate to enhance their qualifications. The short-listing criteria are:

(i) Age of the firm; (ii) Number of Post Graduate Social Sciences, Economics, Statistics, Environmental Science/Forestry, Post Graduate Civil Engineering, Financial analyst, M.Com, MBA, CA as an associates or employee with the firm; (iii) Completed similar assignment since last three financial year (i.e from 1st April, 2011); (iv) Experience of working in similar geographical areas (i.e Himalayan belt of India) and (v) Average annual turnover in last three financial year.

The attention of interested Consultants is drawn to paragraph 1.9 of the World Bank’s Guidelines: Selection and Employment of Consultants [under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants] by World Bank Borrowers, dated January, 2011 (“Consultant Guidelines”), setting forth the World Bank’s policy on conflict of interest. Consultants may associate with other firms in the form of a joint venture or a sub-consultancy to enhance their qualifications.

A Consultant will be selected in accordance with the Qualification & Cost based Selection-Lump-sum method set out in the Consultant Guidelines.
